



Comprehensive Evaluation

The Dyslexia Den works diligently to offer a comprehensive speech-language and literacy evaluation with flexible scheduling to meet the needs of our clients.

Step 1: Initial Evaluation

An initial evaluation consists of a 90 minute session. During that time frame, essential legal forms (e.g., consent to treat, HIPAA, etc.) and a case history form will be completed and discussed. Initial testing begins following the completion of all necessary documents.

*Essential legal forms and the case history form can be provided in advance for completion prior to the initial session, maximizing time spent completing assessments.

Step 2: Further Testing Sessions

Additional testing sessions will be scheduled following the initial evaluation. Typically, 4-6 testing sessions are necessary to complete the comprehensive evaluation. Factors impacting the number of testing sessions necessary to complete the evaluation include child's age, maturity, distractibility, frustration levels while attempting literacy tasks, and the length of the sessions scheduled (45, 60, or 90 minutes sessions).

Step 3: Client and Family Consultation

At the conclusion of testing, the evaluating therapist and family participate in an in-depth 90+ minute consultation. The goal of the consultation is to thoroughly share results and recommendations with the family and to answer questions.

*Though consultations are scheduled for 90 minutes, the session is charged as a 60 minute session.

Step 4: Evaluation Report

Upon the completion of the evaluation, the family will be provided a final evaluation report, stating test scores, interpretations of results, and recommendations.

*Final reports not provided at the final family consultation, to allow for documentation of the final session.
